The successful candidate will assist with the general care and maintenance of trees, vines, irrigation systems, trellis systems and fencing including but not limited to the following tasks:

- Pruning
- Raking
- Planting
- Tree & vine training
- Shoot thinning
- Apple thinning
- Leaf removal
- Hedge trimming
- Colour picking apples
- Picking grapes

This work involves:

- The use of a ladder, pneumatic pruning shears, hand tools and small equipment
- Colour picking apples
- Kneeling, bending and standing for 9 hours per day
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs

The successful candidate will be a flexible team player who has an attention to detail and is able to follow specific instructions. No education required. Experience working in agriculture is an asset but not a requirement. Preference will be given to those with experience working outdoors in landscaping, tree-planting, or agriculture. The applicant must be capable of working in a physically demanding environment and in all weather conditions. Hours of work average 40 hours per week with fluctuations through the year.
